Policy	The Board of Trustees of Seven Generations Charter School believes that for effective learning to take place that class sizes must be held to reasonable limits.
Delegation of Responsibility	The Board of Trustees of Seven Generations Charter School authorizes the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) or his/her designee to enforce this policy.
Guidelines	<p>Class size per grade will be as follows:</p> <p>Grades K through 2 – 18 students Grade 3 – 20 students Grades 4 through 5 – 23 students Grades 6 through 8 – 25 students</p> <p>Multiplying these sizes by the number of classes in any one grade will determine the capacity (cap) for enrollment in that grade. These capacities will not be exceeded except by increasing the number of classes in that grade or by specific action of the Board of Trustees.</p> <p>The number of students in individual classrooms across a grade will generally be distributed evenly so that no classroom has more students than the above numbers. However, there may be circumstances where other factors can also be considered. If there are compelling reasons for exceeding the above figures (by up to one student), the CEO/designee may approve such an exception. However, any such situations must be presented to the Board of Trustees at their next regularly scheduled meeting so that the reasons may be made public and noted in the minutes of that meeting.</p>
