## 2017-2018 Student Supplies List: 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

**NOTE:** Seven Generations will continue to use the “Responsive Classroom” program in all classrooms this year. Through Responsive Classroom principles, we work to establish a strong sense of community. Many of our consumable supplies will be stored and used collectively in our classrooms. Therefore, we ask that you please **DO NOT LABEL *consumable*** school supplies (such as markers, paper, crayons, etc.)

### **Consumable Community Supplies – To be shared with the entire class (DO NOT LABEL):**

- 1 pack of multi-color construction paper
- 6 glue sticks (including 1 big fat one for Art Room)
- 36 #2 pencils (preferably pre-sharpened)
- Box of pencil top erasers
- 2 box of 24 crayons
- 1 box of markers
- 1 box of color pencils
- 1 pack of multi-color highlighters (pink, blue, green, yellow, orange)
- 1 pack of 4-6 Expo brand low odor dry erase markers (any color)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 pack of pink wedge erasers
- 1 pack Post-It Notes
- Last Name A-M = 1 container disinfectant wipes
- Last Name N-Z = 1 bottle hand sanitizer

### **Personal Items – To be used only by your child (LABEL WITH CHILD’S NAME):**

- 1 personal re-useable water bottle
- 1 Take-home folder w/ pockets w/ three holes to go in binder
- 3 composition notebooks (blue, yellow, black)
- 1 blue three prong folder w/ clasps for Math
- 3 green three prong folders w/ clasps for Investigations
- 2 red three prong folders w/ clasps for Fluency & Reading
- 1 folder (any color) for Writing
- 1 one inch binder
- 1 raincoat with hood
- 1 pair of rain pants
- 1 pair of rain boots

### **Teacher Wish List (optional supplies for classroom):**

- Post-it notes (large, note taking)
- Masking tape, Invisible tape
- Magic eraser
- Sharpie permanent markers (any color)
- Binder clips, Paper clips
- Rubber bands
- staples
- 1 Purple Cow or 3M brand laminating pouches (8½ x 11” size)
- 1 pack of copier quality transparencies
- 1 pack of white and/or multi-color cardstock paper (8 ½ x 11” size)

- Ziploc (or any brand) bags in sandwich, gallon, and extra large storage.

**Lunch-Packing Tips:** At Seven Gen we try to generate the least amount of garbage possible. We use a “pack in and pack out” policy, which means that whatever comes in with lunch, leaves in the lunch box. We recommend the following lunch-packing tips to save money and reduce waste:

- Instead of juice boxes or pouches, purchase a small thermos with a tight-fitting lid, or ask your child to use his/her water bottle.
- Instead of packaged foods like Lunchables, purchase a sectioned container that can be filled with different foods. This can be washed and re-used daily.
- Instead of individual apple sauces, puddings, etc., stock up on large jars and re-use containers.
- If you do pack items that will create waste, such as pouches of applesauce, pudding, or Dole fruit cups, send in a sandwich-sized resealable bag for the waste. This way, the used item does not create a mess inside your child’s lunch box after they are finished with it.
