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<p>Policy</p>	<p>The Board of Trustees of Seven Generations Charter School and its parent organization support families and staff who wish to use technology to increase engagement and participation during school meetings. All members of the school community are encouraged to participate in person to the fullest extent possible. When family and work commitments prevent physical attendance, participation in meetings from remote locations may be the next best alternative. The method of remote participation could range from an email/text exchange or phone call with a participant who is attending the meeting to a remote telepresence of the proceedings. Participants would need to participate in the remote meeting during the same time as the physical proceedings.</p> <p>The community recognizes that this service results from volunteer effort. Capabilities and availability will vary over time. If a meeting is planned to be remotely available, a note will be included in the community announcement of the meeting, along with instructions. Technology will fail periodically – thus the most reliable and meaningful participation will happen in person.</p>
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
