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*Annual Public Notice of Special Education Services and Programs, and Services for Protected Services
Child Find*

In compliance with state and federal law, notice is hereby given by the Seven Generations Charter School (SGCS) that it conducts ongoing identification activities as a part of its school program for the purpose identifying students who may be in need of special education and related services. If your child is identified by SGCS as in need of such services, you will be notified of applicable procedures. These services and the transportation to them are paid for by the SGCS and the sending school district. Services and programs are available for children who are determined to need specially designed instruction due to the following conditions:

1. Autism / Pervasive Developmental Disorder
2. Blindness / Visual Impairment
3. Deafness / Hearing Impairment
4. Deafness / Blindness
5. Developmental Delay
6. Emotional Disturbance
7. Intellectual Delay
8. Multiple Disabilities
9. Orthopedic Impairment
10. Other Health Impairment
11. Specific Learning Disability
12. Speech and Language Impairment
13. Traumatic Brain Injury

If you believe that your school-age child may be in need of special education services and related programs, screening and evaluation processes designed to assess the needs of the child and his/her eligibility are available to you at no cost, upon written request. This process may include a review of functional vision, hearing and a review of speech and language. You may request screening and evaluation at any time. Requests for Multidisciplinary Evaluation and screening are to be made in writing to the CEO, Seven Generations Charter School, 154 E. Minor St. Emmaus, PA 18049. Communication with parents or guardians is in English and, if necessary, in the native language or other mode of communication used by the parents or student.

In compliance with state and federal law, the CEO will provide to each protected handicapped student, without discrimination or cost to the student or family, those related aids, services or accommodations which are needed to provide access to participate in and obtain the benefits of the school program. In order to qualify as a protected handicapped student, the child must be of school age with a physical or mental disability which substantially limits or prohibits participation in or access to an aspect of the school program. These services for protected handicapped students are

distinct from those applicable to all exceptional students enrolled (or seeking enrollment) in special education programs.

If a preschool child is suspected of being eligible for early intervention, evaluation and services are provided through your local Intermediate Unit Early Intervention Department. You may also contact the CEO by calling the school at 610-421-8844 for additional information.
