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# Establishment Of A Tiered System

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# Tier 1

## Standard Mitigation Measures

*Low school transmission rate,  
and/or Low to Moderate county  
rate*

- 1) Most school activities will proceed as normal.
- 2) Indoor and Outdoor Field Trips will be permitted
- 3) In-person assemblies will be permitted
- 4) Social distancing will remain in place
- 5) Visitors will be allowed in the building
- 6) Masking will be optional for students
  - a) Masks must be worn in the health room and on public transportation
- 7) Masking will be optional for staff
  - a) Masks must be worn in the health \_\_\_\_\_ room and on public transportation

## Tier 2 Stricter Mitigation Measures

*Low to Moderate school  
transmission rate, and/or Moderate  
to Substantial county rate*

- 1) Outdoor Field Trips will be permitted/ Indoor Field Trips will not be permitted
- 2) In-person assemblies will not take place, but may take place virtually
- 3) Social distancing will remain in place
- 4) 1 Visitor will be permitted per classroom per week
  - a) Visitors must remain masked at all times in the building
- 5) Masking will be required for students indoors
  - a) Outdoors masking will remain optional
  - b) Masks must be worn in the health room and on public transportation
- 6) Masking will be required for staff indoors
  - a) Outdoors masking will remain optional
  - b) Masks must be worn in the health room and on public transportation

# Tier 3

## Strongest Mitigation Measures

*Moderate to Substantial school transmission rate, and/or Substantial county rate*

- 1) Field Trips will not be permitted
- 2) In-person assemblies will not take place, but may take place virtually
- 3) Social distancing will remain in place
- 4) Visitors will not be permitted in the building
- 5) Masking will be required for students indoors
  - a) Static recess groupings will be implemented
  - b) Outdoors masking will remain optional
  - c) Masks must be worn in the health room and on public transportation
- 6) Masking will be required for staff indoors
  - a) Outdoors masking will remain optional
  - b) Masks must be worn in the health room and on public transportation

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# Health Room Updates

Continue utilizing daily screening protocol for all staff and students

Continue contact tracing for individuals diagnosed with or exposed to COVID-19 per Pennsylvania Department of Health and CDC guidelines.

Continue to follow CDC and PA Department of Health's guidelines regarding quarantine and isolation periods.

Continue to ask families to notify school nurse if student or family member has been exposed to or diagnosed with COVID-19.

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# Facilities

## K- 5 Classrooms

- Individual student desks
- Social distancing will be enforced
- Teachers will be given classroom sanitizing equipment
- Hand sanitizing and or hand washing will be encouraged throughout the day
- Groups will remain as static as possible to reduce exposure

## Lunch

- Lunch will continue in students' classrooms to help ensure static groupings

## Recess

- Recess will continue at the ES recess yard.
  - As always, SGCS will encourage as much outdoor learning as possible

  - Contracted cleaning company will continue with nightly sanitizing of high touch surfaces

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# Academics

## 1. Academic Programming

### a. Return to Regular Daily Schedule

- i. M,T, Th, F: 8:15-3:15
- ii. W: 8:15-1:45

### b. Specials

- i. Continue 1:1 student devices, K-5 Chromebooks
  - ii. Devices will remain in school
  - iii. Used for differentiated, individualized instructional needs, benchmark assessments, and to enrich the inquiry based, hands on curriculum. NOT a replacement for teachers teaching or experiential opportunities.
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# ESSER III Funding

The ESSER III Federal funding requires that schools focus on supporting students with closing achievement gaps. Using stakeholder feedback, SGCS determined the following needs for the next three school year:

- Add an additional Learning Support Teacher to allow for smaller, student-focused academic groupings
  - Add two paraprofessionals so that almost each grade level will have one para support individual
  - SGCS will be offering the Summer Academy for the 21-22 school year.
  - Add an additional nurse 3 days a week to support with field trips, medication, and general health room support - Contract through St. Lukes
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# Supporting Our Learners

- Focus on supporting all learners by providing academic, social-emotional, and behavioral supports
  - Considered student and family needs in planning for staffing and programming to ensure continuity of services to address academic, social, emotional, mental health, and wellness needs. Hiring of new staff to decrease student to staff ratio in order to increase student supports available
    - Instructional coach to support teachers in designing and implementing high quality, individualized instruction to meet each student's need
    - Additional learning support teacher to provide special education services to students who have been identified as requiring specially designed instruction
    - Increased support will provide the opportunity for all students to receive small group instruction and guided practice opportunities specifically designed to meet each student's specific needs.
  - SGCS will continue robust SAP, MTSS, and Staff and Student School Wide Positive Behavior Support committees, services, and initiatives. Additionally, SGCS plans to continue our Summer Academy program established during the 20-21 school year. This "4th Semester" provides summer academic instructional opportunities to all students to limit the skill deficits that occur over the summer months that may compound deficits resulting from COVID-19.
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
