What is ESSER?

Approved by Congress and signed into law 3/27/20, The Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief funds are to address the impact that the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) has had, and continues to have on LEAs across the nation. Funds are targeted to help schools safely reopen and sustain safe operation and address the impacts of the coronavirus pandemic on the nation's students.

ESSER II (Supplemental Appropriations Act): \$54.3 billion

ARP/ESSER (American Rescue Plan): \$122 billion
